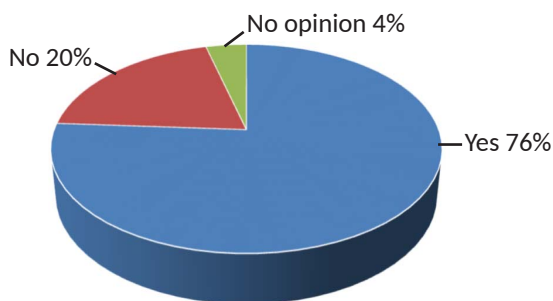

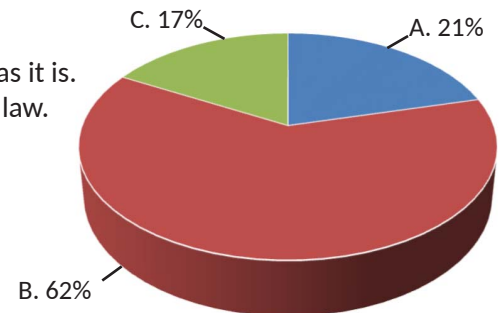

QUESTION: Do you support the Governor’s proposed “hands-free device driving law” banning the use of cellphones while driving?

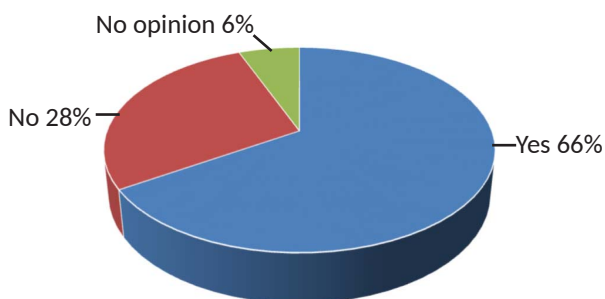

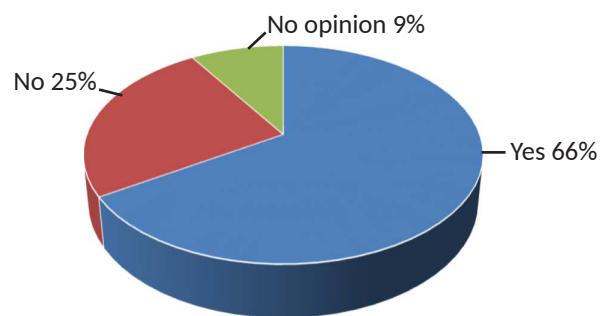
